## **Practical Principles for Practical Living**

Text: Proverbs 10:1-12

## Introduction

In chapter 10, Solomon begins to give a number of "Proverbs" to his son (v.1a). He has spent the former chapters defining wisdom, and demonstrating its practice. He has warned his son concerning the "strange" woman (i.e., the harlot, prostitute, etc.).

Chapters 10-29 are a collection of practical tidbits of life instruction. He fires these bullets of wisdom in rapid succession. No doubt, he has hopes that at least a few of these sharp points will find their way into the heart and life of his son. For he knows that the practice of these practical point will enhance his life, and insure wisdom of life.

<u>DEFINITION</u>: Proverbs are "parables, sayings, ethical wisdom."

We must remember that the Holy Spirit, through Solomon's pen, divides the vast population of humanity into two groups. . . *The Wise*, and *The Fool*. In this collection of practical wisdom, Solomon begins to define the actions, character and lifestyle of these groups.

To assist in his defining of these groups, he uses a series of contrast. In chapter 10, and following, he will make a statement about the wise, and then say "but," and give the opposite statement of a fool.

Notice the contrast as we learn some new Life Principles.
