Text: Proverbs 13:1-25

Introduction

Chapter 13 opens with the admonition to "hear" instruction. Solomon is apparently speaking to his son, Rehoboam, the rebel son. Apparently, Solomon apparently had some of the same rebellion in his heart. David, his father, repented when rebuked by the Prophet Nathan. Yet, Solomon rebelled when rebuked in 1 Kings 11:31-40. He sought to destroy Jeroboam, when he learned of God's anointing upon him by the Prophet Ahijah.

Nevertheless, Solomon is attempting to warn and instruct his son. He knew the day would come when Rehoboam would assume the throne, and he knew there was some preparation to be done.
