Solomon continues his observations about life and people. In this chapter he outlines the differences between the righteous and the wicked. To make these differences more recognizable, he gives a series of contrast.

John Phillips points out, "A good man is placed alongside a bad one. A worthy act is enhanced by being placed alongside a base one. Solomon knew that a flashing diamond seems more lustrous when it is displayed on a black velvet background."
